

## EU Anti-Corruption Initiative (EUACI) Call for Proposals – Ukrainian Registered CSOs

### Stage One – Concept Note: Questions and Answers

This document lists the questions sent to the EUACI regarding the concept note submission (Anti-Corruption Initiative (EUACI) Call for Proposals – Ukrainian Registered CSOs announced on July 2, 2018) and provides answers to the questions received.

***Question 1. In what language should be submitted a concept note?***

Please submit a concept note written in English.

***Question 2. Do you have a template for the concept note?***

We do not have a specific template/form. Please be informed that concept note should comply with the following criteria:

- up to 4 pages (A4 size) of Arial 10 characters with 2 cm margins, single line spacing;
- contains problem identification, targeted goals, objectives and outcomes, as well as target audience, beneficiaries, workplan and a budget based on estimations;
- fully discloses previous experience in the field of implementation the anti-corruption projects.

***Question 3. Can one organization submit several concept notes?***

We will consider only one concept note from one organization.

***Question 4. Do you issue grants to individuals? Do you issue grants to international organizations?***

Only legal entities, non-profit-making, civil society organizations established, registered in Ukraine are eligible for the EUACI grants.

***Question 5. Can organizations that do not have anti-corruption objectives included in their statutory goals apply for the EUACI grants? Are organizations required to have previous experience in implementing anti-corruption projects?***

Organizations that do not have anti-corruption objectives included in their statutory goals are eligible for the EUACI grants. We only require them to have previous experience in the field of implementation of the anti-corruption projects.

***Question 6. Do you have allowable & unallowable costs regulations?***

***Question 7. Do you require any agreements/memorandum between organizations and state institutions to be signed for the first stage, concept note submission stage?***

For the first stage, applicants are not required to have any agreements/memorandum signed.

***Question 8. What kind of activities, project themes will EUACI support with this grant call?***

The objective of this call for proposal is to support CSOs activities focused on:

- development and promotion of accountability and transparency mechanisms on national, regional and local level (including corruption prevention, investigation and follow up on corruption cases);
- asset declaration, conflict of interest prevention, corruption risk assessment;
- oversight over and monitoring of reforms delivery, effectiveness of public services on national, regional and local level;
- support to dialogue on state reforms implementation between civil society, government and other stakeholders;
- anti-corruption advocacy and raising awareness campaign;
- monitoring of use of public resources for election campaigns, oversight of political parties' finances and activities;
- civic education for youth and youth involvement in finding innovative ways to address corruption.

***Question 9. Will you support a project focused on implementing activities only in one region?***

A project can be implemented in one region. We support implementation of the anti-corruption mechanisms on national, regional and local level.

***Question 10. Do you provide pre-evaluation services to the applicants? Can we send you either our project summary or concept note before the deadline and get your feedback on it?***

EUACI ensures fair competition. We can't provide any pre-evaluation services to the applicants, we can't give any feedback on the project summary or concept note submitted before the deadline.
